



TRAVEL AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR JANUARY-FEBRUARY VOYAGES

The information presented below is current as January 13, 2022. As health and entry requirements vary by country and are rapidly evolving, we strongly suggest you re-check this information five (5) days prior to commencing travel.

The information contained in this document is applicable to the following voyages:

Riviera – January 28, February 27 (pages 4 to 7)

Marina – January 22, February 1, February 11 (pages 7 to 9)

Insignia – January 29 (pages 9 to 11)

BEFORE YOU TRAVEL

Please ensure that prior to commencing travel, you have all of the travel documents and pre-travel testing that are required:

- Air tickets and cruise documents
- Passport
- Original/Official COVID-19 vaccination record – hard copy and/or electronic
- Pre-travel antigen or PCR test results
- Your completed PLF, if required

PRE-EMBARKATION TESTING

Until further notice, all guests will undergo complimentary pier-side COVID-19 antigen testing prior to embarkation. Additionally, we strongly recommend that all guests consult with local government websites to determine the country-specific information for your port of embarkation as many countries require a negative COVID-19 PCR test that is not older than 48 or 72 hours prior to arrival in-country.

Even if the country where your cruise embarks does not require a negative COVID-19 PCR test for entry, Oceania Cruises strongly recommends you obtain a PCR test not more than 72 hours prior to embarkation. If a PCR test is not readily available, then we encourage guests to, at a minimum, take a laboratory-administered COVID-19 antigen test not more than 72 hours prior to embarkation.

Guests that fail to test prior to departure, or cannot provide proof of a negative laboratory-supplied test result, and subsequently test positive for COVID-19 upon embarkation will not be reimbursed for quarantine or return arrangements.

FACE MASK REQUIREMENTS

The health and safety of our guests and crew is always our number one priority and at the advice of the medical experts on our **SailSAFE Global Health and Wellness Council**, for all sailings departing after December 18, 2021 and until further notice, all guests will be required to wear face masks in all public areas of the ship, unless eating or drinking while seated. Masks are also required outdoors when physical distancing of at least six (6) feet cannot be maintained. Face masks must fully cover the nose and mouth, down to the chin. Gaiters and other loose facial coverings are not acceptable. Additionally, many destinations have very specific face mask requirements for going ashore. We strongly recommend all guests travel with an adequate supply of medical-grade masks, commonly known as surgical masks or KN-95 masks. Should you require additional masks while traveling, all ships will be adequately stocked and you may obtain them from your Stateroom or Suite Attendant or at Reception. We thank you for your cooperation and understanding. Please note: this guidance is subject to change as the global health map evolves.

TRAVEL/MEDICAL INSURANCE

Oceania Cruises strongly urges all guests to travel with adequate travel insurance to cover unforeseen medical expenses. Some destinations have enacted mandates for all travelers to carry travel-medical insurance.

CHECK-IN AND CRUISE TERMINAL ARRIVAL

All guests are reminded to arrive at the cruise terminal within a 30-minute window of their reserved embarkation time.

EXPLORING ASHORE

At the time of issue of this guidance, many destinations are updating their guidelines on independent touring. While the majority of destinations on our itineraries permit guests to tour independently, the situation remains fluid and may change without notice. The latest country-specific information is listed below and is subject to change.

REQUIRED TESTING DURING YOUR VOYAGE

Any testing that may be required by authorities to enter a port of call will be carried out aboard the vessel and will be complimentary. For voyages that require antigen tests prior to disembarkation, Oceania Cruises will administer them on board free of charge for those guests who require a test to return home. Note: voyages sailing roundtrip from U.S. ports have no end of cruise testing requirements to disembark. If a PCR test is required for any travel home, Oceania Cruises will administer and pay for a PCR test only for those guests whose home country specifically requires a PCR test. It is the responsibility of the guest to determine which test is required for their return home and to confirm if the PCR test the Cruise Line is offering will be accepted by their home country. For voyages that end at a

U.S. port, the PCR test will be administered shoreside after disembarkation and results are normally available within 90 minutes.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

All guests and crew are required to be fully vaccinated. Fully vaccinated means that you have fulfilled your complete cycle of inoculations (a single shot of a single dose vaccine or two shots of a dual dose vaccine) and are 15 days or more past your final shot.

Oceania Cruises strongly recommends that all guests receive a COVID-19 “booster” prior to travel.

Approved Vaccinations

- Any FDA/EMA/WHO authorized single brand vaccination protocol ≥ 2 weeks after receipt of the final dose.
 - I.e., J&J Janssen, Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, AstraZeneca/Oxford (Vaxzevria & CoviShield), etc.
 - A mixed vaccination combination of two doses of an FDA approved/authorized or WHO Emergency Use Listed (EUL) COVID-19 two-dose series with a minimum interval of 17 days.
- **Note:** Individuals receiving a Janssen COVID-19 vaccine before or after another COVID-19 vaccine are considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 ≥ 2 weeks after receipt of the single dose of the Janssen vaccine.
- **Current Unauthorized Vaccine:** Sputnik V, Inactivated SARS-CoV-2 Vaccine (Vero-Cell), Novavax, Covovax.
- **Children between the ages of 5-11:** Allowed provided they have received and completed the full vaccination protocol ≥ 2 weeks after receipt of the final dose of Pfizer-BioNTech only.

Notes: Individuals receiving a J&J Janssen COVID-19 vaccine before or after another COVID-19 vaccine are considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 ≥ 2 weeks after receipt of the single dose of the J&J Janssen vaccine.

Vaccinations received via clinical trials will not be accepted as they do not specify vaccine received. A single shot of a dual dose vaccine or antibodies from COVID-19 recovery is NOT considered being fully vaccinated. Therefore, two administered doses/shots of AstraZeneca, Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, Sinopharm or Sinovac or a single shot of a single dose vaccination ≥ 15 days equals fully vaccinated.

We take health and safety matters extremely seriously and under certain circumstances onboard services could be impacted or limited to provide the safest environment possible. In the event you test positive at the terminal prior to embarkation or test positive for COVID-19 during your cruise, there are mandatory isolation protocols that must be followed, including close contact quarantine requirements in accordance with CDC guidelines specific to cruise vessels. These include the following:

These include the following:

- Guests who test positive at the terminal prior to embarkation and who are asymptomatic will be required to quarantine for 5 days in a hotel arranged by Oceania Cruises.
- Guests who test positive during the cruise, both symptomatic and asymptomatic, will be required to quarantine for 10 days onboard.
- If the cruise ends prior to the 10-day mandatory onboard quarantine period:
 - o If the guest is symptomatic at the end of the cruise the guest will be required to complete the remainder of their 10-day mandatory quarantine upon disembarkation at a hotel arranged by Oceania Cruises.
 - o If the guest is asymptomatic and has completed 5 days of quarantine onboard, the guest may disembark at the end of the cruise and travel home as scheduled.
 - o If the guest is asymptomatic and has completed less than 5 days in quarantine onboard the guest will be required to complete the remainder of their quarantine upon disembarkation at a hotel arranged by Oceania Cruises. A total of 5 quarantine days will be required, combining days in quarantine onboard and ashore.
 - For example, if a guest is asymptomatic at the end of the cruise and has quarantined for 4 days onboard prior to the end of the cruise, they will be required to quarantine for 1 additional day at a hotel prior to traveling home.

RIVIERA VOYAGE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS – JANUARY 28, 2022

In the event the sailing is cut short, all guests will receive a prorated refund based on the original form of payment for the nights not sailed.

ST. BARTS

Testing Required: No

Entry Restrictions: As St. Barts is a territory of France, all French vaccination requirements apply.

- All guests must have proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- Proof of vaccination may be requested or required for entry into cafes, restaurants, bars, shops, attractions, and any establishment of public accommodation.
- Face Masks are mandatory in/on all forms of transportation, in all indoor spaces, and outdoors when and where social distancing is not possible.
- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

MARTINIQUE

Testing Required: TBD

Entry Restrictions: As Martinique is a territory of France, all French vaccination requirements apply.

- All guests must have proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- Proof of vaccination may be requested or required for entry into cafes, restaurants, bars, shops, attractions, and any establishment of public accommodation.
- Face Masks are mandatory in/on all forms of transportation, in all indoor spaces, and outdoors when and where social distancing is not possible.
- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

NOTE: As of the date of issuance of his guidance (January 13, 2022), Martinique remains closed to cruise ship travel.

SAINT LUCIA

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 48 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions:

- All guests must have proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- No “free flow” tourism is permitted
 - Guests may explore ashore on cruise line sponsored shore excursions OR by utilizing an authorized, independent tour guide or taxi that may take them to locations/sites authorized by the government OR participate in walk-around activities within the confines of the port’s restaurant and bar areas.

ANTIGUA

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 48 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions: All guests must present proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

PUERTO RICO

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 24 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions: All guests must present proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Face masks must be worn at all times when ashore

DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Testing Required: No.

Entry Restrictions: All guests must present proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

RIVIERA VOYAGE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS – FEBRUARY 7, 2022

In the event the sailing is cut short, all guests will receive a prorated refund based on the original form of payment for the nights not sailed.

ARUBA

Testing Required: No.

Entry Restrictions:

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

- Face masks must be worn at all times when ashore

CURACAO

Testing Required: No.

Entry Restrictions:

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Face masks must be worn at all times when ashore

BONAIRE

Testing Required: A negative antigen test is required for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions:

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Face masks must be worn at all times when ashore

GRENADA

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 48 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions:

- All guests must have proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- No “free flow” tourism is permitted
 - Guests may explore ashore on cruise line sponsored shore excursions OR by utilizing a government certified independent tour guide OR taxi that may take them to government authorized beach locations only. Guests touring with independent operators will need to present proof of booking from the tour operator to leave the port area.

BARBADOS

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 48 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions:

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

ANTIGUA

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 48 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions: All guests must present proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

GUADELOUPE

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 48 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions:

- All guests must have proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- All guests aged 65 or older, who are vaccinated with a Janssen (J&J) vaccine, must provide proof of a booster.

NOTE: As of the date of issuance of his guidance (January 13, 2022), Martinique remains closed to cruise ship travel.

ST. BARTS

Testing Required: No

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

HARVEST CAYE

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 72 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions: All guests must present proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.

- Guests may tour freely on Harvest Caye. Guests wishing to proceed may via cruise line shore excursions or with government certified “Gold Standard” tour operators.

SANTO TOMAS

Testing Required: No.

Entry Restrictions: No.

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

ROATAN**Testing Required:** No.**Entry Restrictions:** No.

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

PUERTO LIMON**Testing Required:** No.**Entry Restrictions:**

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Face masks may be required when ashore

PANAMA CITY**Testing Required:** No.**Entry Restrictions:** No.

- Guests must present proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

MARINA VOYAGE REQUIREMENTS – FEBRUARY 1, 2022**PANAMA CITY**

- All travelers must complete and submit a Health Declaration Form before boarding. The form can be found [here](#)
- All travelers must present a negative COVID-19 PCR or antigen test certificate issued no more than 72 hours prior to boarding; or proof of a complete vaccination scheme endorsed by the WHO, EMA and FDA, equal to or greater than 14 days after the last dose. Travelers must upload their COVID-19 test or vaccination card as part of the online Declaration Form process mentioned above and present the original to the government authorities on arrival.
- Once checked-in and embarked, guests are free to proceed ashore. Proof of vaccination is required and guests may tour independently.

PUERTO LIMON**Testing Required:** No.**Entry Restrictions:**

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Face masks may be required when ashore

Entry Restrictions: All guests must present proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.

- Guests may tour freely on Harvest Caye. Guests wishing to proceed may via cruise line shore excursions or with government certified “Gold Standard” tour operators.

COSTA MAYA

Testing Required: No.

Entry Restrictions: No.

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

COZUMEL

Testing Required: No.

Entry Restrictions: No.

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

UNITED STATES

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 24 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to disembark. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions: Yes.

- All guests must provide proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- All guests must wear face masks while in the cruise terminal.

INSIGNIA PRELIMINARY VOYAGE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS – JANUARY 29, 2022

International travel has always required a measure of flexibility and even more so today. We will do everything in our power to deliver the destination experience you are expecting, but port closures and local restrictions may dictate that we amend itineraries during the course of your voyage, which could result in additional days at sea. In the event the sailing is cut short, all guests will receive a prorated refund based on the original form of payment for the nights not sailed.

PLEASE NOTE: Updated guidance is anticipated from many of the destinations listed below and we will provide updates as we receive them.

VOYAGE EMBARKATION REQUIREMENTS - FRENCH POLYNESIA

FRENCH POLYNESIA

Testing Required: Yes.

- All travelers entering French Polynesia must be in possession of a negative PCR test that is not more than 24 hours old at the time of arrival.
- OR travelers may be in possession of a negative PCR test that is not more than 48 hours old upon arrival PLUS a negative laboratory-administered antigen test that is not more than 24 hours old upon arrival.

- OR travelers may present a negative, laboratory administered antigen test that is not more than 24 hours old upon arrival AND submit to government mandated PCR testing upon arrival at Faa'a International Airport.
- All guests will undergo additional antigen testing prior to embarkation, per our standard protocols.

Entry Restrictions: Yes.

- All travelers, regardless of their country of departure and vaccination status, must register on the [E.T.I.S \(Electronic travel information system\)](#) between 30 days and 6 days before boarding their flight to French Polynesia. After registering, the traveler will receive an email which will need to be presented at the check-in. Children under the age of 18 can be registered on their parents' form.
- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

AMERICAN SAMOA

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 24 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to disembark. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions: Yes.

- All guests must provide proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

SAMOA

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 24 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to disembark. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions: Yes.

- All guests must provide proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

FIJI

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 72 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to disembark. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions: Yes.

- All guests must provide proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- Travelers (foreign nationals entering Fiji for a holiday) must have proof of insurance for COVID-19 coverage. Many travel insurance companies now include this coverage in their standard policies but if yours does not, you can also purchase one online prior to travel with [Fiji Care](#). For enquiries you can also email them at customercare@fijivisitorsinsurance.com
- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions

VANUATU

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 72 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to disembark. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions: Yes.

- All guests must provide proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- All guests are subject to testing by Vanuatu officials upon arrival

NEW CALEDONIA

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 24 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to disembark. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions: Yes.

- All guests must provide proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

PAPUA NEW GUINEA

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative PCR test not older than 72 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to disembark. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions: Yes.

- All travelers entering Papua New Guinea are required to get approval from the Controller's Office through the COVID-19 Travel Desk Team and have to submit their completed documents at least two weeks prior to travel.
- All travelers must complete a Health Declaration Form no more than 24 hours before boarding. The form can be found [here](#)
- All travelers must present a negative COVID-19 PCR test result issued no more than 7 days before departure
- All travelers will be tested upon arrival

INDONESIA

Testing Required: Yes. All guests must present a negative PCR test not older than 72 hours old at the time of arrival, for authorization to disembark. This testing will be conducted onboard, free of charge.

Entry Restrictions: Yes.
