

#### TRAVEL AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR MARCH VOYAGES

The information presented below is current and believed accurate as of February 22, 2022. As health and entry requirements vary by country and are rapidly evolving, we strongly suggest you re-check this information five (5) days prior to commencing travel. While this information is provided as a courtesy to our guests, destinations we travel to may have very specific entry requirements that exclude certain nationalities or travelers originating from certain destinations. It is the responsibility of the guest to ensure they meet the entry requirements for each destination.

ALL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS LISTED ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE

#### **BEFORE YOU TRAVEL**

Please ensure that prior to commencing travel, you have all of the travel documents and pre-travel testing that are required:

- Air tickets and cruise documents
- Passport
- Original/Official COVID-19 vaccination record hard copy and/or electronic
- Pre-travel antigen or PCR test results
- Your completed PLF, if required

#### PRE-EMBARKATION TESTING

Even if the country where your cruise embarks does not require a negative COVID-19 PCR test for entry, Oceania Cruises strongly recommends you obtain a PCR test not more than 72 hours prior to embarkation. If a PCR test is not readily available, then we encourage guests to at a minimum take a laboratory administered COVID-19 antigen test not more than 72 hours prior to embarkation. Guests that fail to test prior to departure or cannot provide proof of a negative laboratory supplied test result and subsequently test positive for COVID-19 upon embarkation will not be reimbursed for quarantine or return embarkation arrangements.

Simply enter your zip code, or city and country, and the website will display locations, contact information, and testing hours. It also allows you to search by test type – PCR or antigen.

**FOR SAILINGS EMBARKING AFTER MARCH 1, 2022,** Oceania Cruises will require that all guests arrive at the embarkation terminal with a negative COVID-19 PCR or Antigen test result from a third-party verified laboratory or pharmacy, taken within 48 hours of arriving to the terminal for cruises beginning in a U.S. port or within 72 hours for all other cruises. All guests must provide proof of a negative test

result at embarkation in a digital or printed format. Guests not in possession of a negative, third-party Covid-19 test result will not be allowed to embark for the voyage.

Test result documentation must be provided in English and must include the following information:

- Your name, which should match the name on your travel documents
- Your date of birth
- The result of the test
- The date the test sample was collected
- The name of the test provider
- Confirmation of the type of test provided

Additionally, we have partnered with Inspire Diagnostics to provide hassle-free, online testing for our guests from the convenience of your own home. Inspire Diagnostics is a subsidiary of Inspire Health Alliance, a leader in best-in-class health services that provides FDA-approved, proctored, in-home antigen testing for our guests.

For guests unable to arrange a test within 48 or 72 hours of arriving to the terminal, Oceania Cruises will have on-site testing available at the pier for a fee – pricing will be subject to local availability and the discretion of the testing provider. Please be advised that testing at the terminal may result in delayed embarkation. In the event you test positive at the terminal prior to embarkation there are mandatory isolation protocols that must be followed, including close contact quarantine requirements in accordance with CDC guidelines specific to cruise vessels.

PLEASE NOTE: Voyages that include Bermuda have very specific pore-embarkation testing requirements. Please pay careful attention to the voyage specific requirements.

Oceania Cruises will continue to evaluate and adjust pre-cruise testing requirements as the global health map evolves and we will communicate any changes in as timely a fashion as is practicable. Additionally, should local requirements in any embarkation ports require pre-boarding testing, we will notify those guests in advance of travel.

## **FACE MASK REQUIREMENTS**

As part of our stringent health and safety protocols, all of our guests and crew are fully vaccinated. All guests are required to provide a negative COVID-19 test or undergo pierside testing prior to embarkation. Our vaccination policy and universal pre-embarkation testing of guests are coupled with numerous additional layers of protection against COVID-19.

While face coverings are optional for guests, we continue to strongly recommend that all guests wear face coverings when outside of their accommodations. Our Officers and Crew will continue to remain masked at all times. We strongly recommend all guests travel with an adequate supply of medical grade masks, commonly known as surgical masks or KN-95 masks. Should you require additional masks while traveling, all ships will be adequately stocked. We thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

Please note: this guidance is subject to change as the global health map evolves.

## TRAVEL/MEDICAL INSURANCE

Oceania Cruises strongly urges all guests to travel with adequate travel insurance to cover unforeseen medical expenses. Some destinations have enacted mandates for all travelers to carry travel-medical insurance.

#### **CHECK-IN AND CRUISE TERMINAL ARRIVAL**

All guests are reminded to arrive at the cruise terminal within a 30-minute window of their reserved embarkation time.

#### **EXPLORING ASHORE**

At the time of issue of this guidance, many destinations are updating their guidelines on independent touring. While the majority of destinations on our itineraries permit guests to tour independently, the situation remains fluid and may change without notice. The latest country-specific information is listed below and is subject to change.

#### **REQUIRED TESTING DURING YOUR VOYAGE**

Any testing that may be required by authorities to enter a port of call will be carried out aboard the vessel and will be complimentary. For voyages that require antigen tests prior to disembarkation, Oceania Cruises will administer them on board free of charge for those guests who require a test to return home. Note: voyages sailing roundtrip from U.S. ports have no end-of-cruise testing requirements to disembark. If a PCR test is required for any travel home, Oceania Cruises will administer and pay for a PCR test only for those guests whose home country specifically requires a PCR test. It is the responsibility of the guest to determine which test is required for their return home and to confirm if the PCR test the Cruise Line is offering will be accepted by their home country. For voyages that end at a U.S. port, the PCR test will be administered shoreside after disembarkation and results are normally available within 90 minutes.

## **VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS**

All guests sailing are required to be fully vaccinated, at least 2 weeks prior to departure, in order to board. Vaccines, combined with multi-layered and robust preventative health and safety measures, including universal COVID-19 testing prior to embarkation, will help us provide a uniquely safe and healthy vacation environment that we believe exceeds all other vacation choices on land and at sea. Each guest must acknowledge and attest to their vaccination status prior to their sailing and bring proof of vaccination to the cruise terminal when checking in for their voyage. Guests who are not old enough to be vaccinated or otherwise not eligible to be vaccinated will not be permitted to sail.

Vaccines received via clinical trials that do not specify vaccine, dose, and date received will not be accepted.

Oceania Cruises' definition of fully vaccinated means to have completed the full brand vaccination protocol at least 15 days prior to embarkation. Therefore two administered doses/shots of AstraZeneca, Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, Sinopharm or Sinovac, etc; or a single shot of a single dose vaccination + 15 days equals fully vaccinated. A single shot of a dual dose vaccine or antibodies from Covid-19 recovery is NOT considered being fully vaccinated.

PLEASE NOTE: Guests must ultimately comply with all destination-specific vaccination requirements and definitions which may change without notice. All guests are strongly recommended to get a covid-19 booster prior to traveling. Oceania Cruises cannot be held responsible for any guests who are denied entry to a destination due to lack of proper vaccination documentation or failing to meet a specific destination's covid vaccination definitions or requirements.

## **Approved Vaccinations**

- Any FDA/EMA/WHO-authorized single brand vaccination protocol ≥2 weeks after receipt of the final dose.
  - I.e., J&J Janssen, Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, AstraZeneca/Oxford (Vaxzevria & CoviShield), etc.
  - A mixed vaccination combination of two doses of an FDA-approved/authorized or WHO Emergency Use Listed (EUL) COVID-19 two-dose series with a minimum interval of 17 days.
- **Note:** Individuals receiving a Janssen COVID-19 vaccine before or after another COVID-19 vaccine are considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 ≥2 weeks after receipt of the single dose of the Janssen vaccine.
- **Current Unauthorized Vaccine:** Sputnik V, Inactivated SARS-CoV-2 Vaccine (Vero-Cell), Novavax, Covovax.
- Children between the ages of 5-11: Allowed provided they have received and completed the full vaccination protocol ≥2 weeks after receipt of the final dose of <u>Pfizer-BioNTech only</u>.

**Notes:** Individuals receiving a J&J Janssen COVID-19 vaccine before or after another COVID-19 vaccine are considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 ≥2 weeks after receipt of the single dose of the J&J Janssen vaccine.

Vaccinations received via clinical trials will not be accepted as they do not specify vaccine received. A single shot of a dual dose vaccine or antibodies from COVID-19 recovery is NOT considered being fully vaccinated. Therefore, two administered doses/shots of AstraZeneca, Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, Sinopharm or Sinovac or a single shot of a single-dose vaccination ≥15 days equals fully vaccinated.

We take health and safety matters extremely seriously and under certain circumstances, onboard services could be impacted or limited to provide the safest environment possible. In the event you test positive at the terminal prior to embarkation or test positive for COVID-19 during your cruise, there are mandatory isolation protocols that must be followed, including close-contact quarantine requirements in accordance with CDC guidelines specific to cruise vessels. These include the following:

- Guests who test positive at the terminal prior to embarkation and who are asymptomatic will be required to quarantine for 5 days in a hotel arranged by Oceania Cruises.
- Guests who test positive during the cruise, both symptomatic and asymptomatic, will be required to guarantine for 10 days on board.
- If the cruise ends prior to the 10-day mandatory onboard quarantine period:
  - If the guest is symptomatic at the end of the cruise, the guest will be required to complete the remainder of their 10-day mandatory quarantine upon disembarkation at a hotel arranged by Oceania Cruises.
  - If the guest is asymptomatic and has completed 5 days of quarantine on board, the guest may disembark at the end of the cruise and travel home as scheduled.
  - If the guest is asymptomatic and has completed less than 5 days in quarantine on board, the guest will be required to complete the remainder of their quarantine upon disembarkation at a hotel arranged by Oceania Cruises. A total of 5 quarantine days will be required, combining days in quarantine on board and ashore.
    - For example, if a guest is asymptomatic at the end of the cruise and has
      quarantined for 4 days on board prior to the end of the cruise, they will be
      required to quarantine for 1 additional day at a hotel prior to traveling home.

#### MARINA VOYAGE REQUIREMENTS – March 5, 2022

#### ST. MAARTEN

- Face masks must be worn at all times when ashore

#### MARINA VOYAGE REQUIREMENTS – March 19, 2022

International travel has always required a measure of flexibility and even more so today. We will do everything in our power to deliver the destination experience you are expecting, but port closures and local restrictions may dictate that we amend itineraries during the course of your voyage, which could result in additional days at sea. In the event the sailing is cut short, all guests will receive a prorated refund based on the original form of payment for the nights not sailed.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Destinations on this voyage have very specific entry requirements that may exclude certain nationalities or travelers originating from certain destinations. It is the responsibility of the guest to ensure they meet the entry requirements for each destination.

## **BERMUDA**

**Testing Required:** Yes. All guests must present a negative PCR test result not more than 4 days old at the time of embarkation. Guests must fill out a Bermuda Travel Authorization form and upload their negative test result and pay an application fee of \$75 per guest.

## BERMUDA TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION

All guests will need to retain a copy of their Travel Authorization to embark the vessel in Miami and be cleared ashore upon arrival in Bermuda.

All guests will also undergo mandatory, supervised, antigen testing at the cruise terminal in Miami, prior to embarking the vessel.

**Entry Restrictions:** All guests must present Travel Authorization and proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.

• Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

#### PORTUGAL – PONTA DELGADA

**Testing Required:** Yes, a negative antigen test not more than 24 hours old at the time of arrival. **Entry Restrictions:** 

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Guests must carry proof of vaccination when going ashore.

## PORTUGAL – FUNCHAL Testing Required: No. Entry Restrictions:

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Guests must carry proof of vaccination when going ashore.

## **RIVIERA VOYAGE REQUIREMENTS – March 8, 2022**

local restrictions may dictate that we amend itineraries during the course of your voyage, which could result in additional days at sea. In the event the sailing is cut short, all guests will receive a prorated refund based on the original form of payment for the nights not sailed.

#### ST.BARTS

Testing Required: No

**Entry Restrictions:** As St. Barts is a territory of France, all French vaccination requirements apply.

- All guests must have proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- All guests aged 65 and over must provide proof of a COVID-19 booster shot.
- Proof of vaccination may be requested or required for entry into cafes, restaurants, bars, shops, attractions, and any establishment of public accommodation.
- Face masks are mandatory in/on all forms of transportation, in all indoor spaces, and outdoors when and where social distancing is not possible.
- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

## **MARTINIQUE**

Testing Required: TBD

Entry Restrictions: As Martinique is a territory of France, all French vaccination requirements apply.

- All guests must have proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- Proof of vaccination may be requested or required for entry into cafes, restaurants, bars, shops, attractions, and any establishment of public accommodation.
- Face masks are mandatory in/on all forms of transportation, in all indoor spaces, and outdoors when and where social distancing is not possible.
- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

**NOTE:** As of the date of issuance of this guidance Martinique remains closed to cruise ship travel.

#### ST. LUCIA

**Testing Required:** Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 48 hours old at the time of arrival for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted on board, free of charge.

#### **Entry Restrictions:**

- All guests must have proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- No "free flow" tourism is permitted
  - Guests may explore ashore on cruise line-sponsored shore excursions OR by utilizing an authorized, independent tour guide or taxi that may take them to locations/sites authorized by the government OR participate in walk-around activities within the confines of the port's restaurant and bar areas.

#### **ANTIGUA**

**Testing Required:** No. **Entry Restrictions:** 

- All guests must present proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

#### **PUERTO RICO**

**Testing Required:** Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 24 hours old at the time of arrival for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted on board, free of charge.

**Entry Restrictions:** All guests must present proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Face masks must be worn at all times when ashore.

## DOMINICAN REPUBLIC Testing Required: No. Entry Restrictions:

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Face masks must be worn at all times when ashore

#### RIVIERA VOYAGE REQUIREMENTS – March 18, 2022

We will do everything in our power to deliver the destination experience you are expecting, but port closures and local restrictions may dictate that we amend itineraries during the course of your voyage, which could result in additional days at sea. In the event the sailing is cut short, all guests will receive a prorated refund based on the original form of payment for the nights not sailed.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Destinations on this voyage have very specific entry requirements that may exclude certain nationalities or travelers originating from certain destinations. It is the responsibility of the guest to ensure they meet the entry requirements for each destination.

## **BERMUDA**

**Testing Required:** Yes. All guests must present a negative PCR test result not more than 4 days old at the time of embarkation. Guests must fill out a Bermuda Travel Authorization form and upload their negative test result and pay an application fee of \$75 per guest.

## **BERMUDA TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION**

All guests will need to retain a copy of their Travel Authorization to embark the vessel in Miami and be cleared ashore upon arrival in Bermuda.

All guests will also undergo mandatory, supervised, antigen testing at the cruise terminal in Miami, prior to embarking the vessel.

**Entry Restrictions:** All guests must present Travel Authorization and proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.

## **PORTUGAL**

We will do everything in our power to deliver the destination experience you are expecting, but port closures and local restrictions may dictate that we amend itineraries during the course of your voyage, which could result in additional days at sea. In the event the sailing is cut short, all guests will receive a prorated refund based on the original form of payment for the nights not sailed.

#### **BARBADOS**

Guests may tour independently through private operators or via cruise line shore excursions
without testing. Guests wishing to "free flow" tour must present a negative antigen test to leave
the port.

  - Guests may explore ashore on cruise line-sponsored shore excursions OR by utilizing an authorized, independent tour guide or taxi that may take them to locations/sites authorized by the government OR participate in walk-around activities within the confines of the port's restaurant and bar areas.

- Guests must wear face masks to go ashore.

#### ST. KITTS

**Testing Required:** A negative antigen test is required for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted on board, free of charge.

#### **Entry Restrictions:**

• Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

## U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS Testing Required: No Entry Restrictions:

• Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

## DOMINICAN REPUBLIC Testing Required: No. Entry Restrictions:

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Face masks must be worn at all times when ashore

#### **JAMAICA**

**Testing Required:** No. **Entry Restrictions:** 

- All guests must have proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
  - No "free flow" tourism is permitted, guests may explore ashore on cruise line-sponsored shore excursions.

#### **HONDURAS**

**Testing Required:** No. **Entry Restrictions:** 

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Face masks must be worn at all times when ashore

## **GUATEMALA**

**Testing Required:** No. **Entry Restrictions:** 

• Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

## **BELIZE**

**Testing Required:** Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than 72 hours old at the time of arrival for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted on board, free of charge.

#### **Entry Restrictions:**

- All guests must present proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.
- Guests may tour freely on Harvest Caye. Guests wishing to proceed may via cruise line shore excursions or with government-certified "Gold Standard" tour operators.

#### **MEXICO**

**Testing Required:** No. **Entry Restrictions:** 

• Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.

#### **UNITED STATES**

**Testing Required:** Yes. All guests must present a negative antigen test not older than one (1) day at the time of arrival for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted on board, free of charge.

#### **Entry Restrictions:**

All guests must present proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.

### INSIGNIA VOYAGE REQUIREMENTS – March 23, 2022

International travel has always required a measure of flexibility and even more so today. We will do everything in our power to deliver the destination experience you are expecting, but port closures and local restrictions may dictate that we amend itineraries during the course of your voyage, which could result in additional days at sea. In the event the sailing is cut short, all guests will receive a prorated refund based on the original form of payment for the nights not sailed.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Destinations on this voyage have very specific entry requirements that may exclude certain nationalities or travelers originating from certain destinations. It is the responsibility of the guest to ensure they meet the entry requirements for each destination.

#### **BERMUDA**

**Testing Required:** Yes. All guests must present a negative PCR test result not more than 4 days old at the time of embarkation. Guests must fill out a Bermuda Travel Authorization form and upload their negative test result and pay an application fee of \$75 per guest.

## BERMUDA TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION

All guests will need to retain a copy of their Travel Authorization to embark the vessel in Miami and be cleared ashore upon arrival in Bermuda.

All guests will also undergo mandatory, supervised, antigen testing at the cruise terminal in Miami, prior to embarking the vessel.

**Entry Restrictions:** All guests must present Travel Authorization and proof of vaccination to proceed ashore.

#### PORTUGAL – PONTA DELGADA

**Testing Required:** Yes, a negative antigen test not more than 24 hours old at the time of arrival. This test will be performed onboard, free of charge.

#### **Entry Restrictions:**

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Guests must carry proof of vaccination when going ashore.

#### **MORROCCO**

**Testing Required:** Yes. All guests must present a negative PCR test not older than 48 hours old at the time of arrival for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted on board, free of charge.

#### **Entry Restrictions:**

- All guests must complete a PLF and present a copy upon arrival.
- Guests must carry proof of vaccination when going ashore.

## **ISRAEL**

**Testing Required:** Yes, a negative antigen test not more than 24 hours old at the time of arrival. This test will be performed onboard, free of charge. All guests must undergo government mandated PCR testing, at the travelers expense, upon arrival in Israel.

#### **Entry Restrictions:**

- Guests may tour independently or via cruise line shore excursions.
- Guests must carry proof of vaccination when going ashore.
- All guests must complete and submit an online Entry Statement form 48 hours before arrival.
   Travelers will be required to upload either a digital vaccination certificate or proof of vaccination administered abroad. Travelers who submit a verifiable proof of vaccination will receive a Green Pass before arrival. The form can be found <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>.

#### **TURKEY**

**Testing Required:** Yes. All guests must present a negative PCR test not older than 48 hours old at the time of arrival for authorization to proceed ashore. This testing will be conducted on board, free of charge.

## **Entry Restrictions:**

Guests must carry proof of vaccination when going ashore.

#### **GREECE**

**Testing Required:** No testing is required for fully vaccinated travelers.

#### **Entry Restrictions:**

- Greece considers you fully vaccinated if your initial vaccination (one or two dose regimen) took
  place nine months ago or less than prior to arrival. If you have subsequently received a booster
  shot, you are considered fully vaccinated.
- Travelers that do not meet the definition of fully vaccinated may be subject to mandatory testing.
- Guests must carry proof of vaccination when going ashore.
- All travelers are required to complete an online Passenger Locator Form at least 24 hours prior
  to arrival. The form can be uploaded <a href="here">here</a> using a browser other than Internet Explorer. Once
  completed, the online form will generate a QR code which must be presented on arrival

## **REGATTA VOYAGE REQUIREMENTS – FRENCH POLYNESIA – MARCH 2022**

International travel has always required a measure of flexibility and even more so today. We will do everything in our power to deliver the destination experience you are expecting, but port closures and local restrictions may dictate that we amend itineraries during the course of your voyage, which could result in additional days at sea. In the event the sailing is cut short, all guests will receive a prorated refund based on the original form of payment for the nights not sailed.

# PLEASE NOTE THESE REQUIREMENTS ARE VALID AS OF THE DATE OF DISTRIBUTION AND ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE

All travelers, age 12+, are now required to present to the air carrier upon boarding a negative result of a RT-PCR or antigen test, carried out within 24 hours prior to boarding their departing flight to French Polynesia. Airlines must ensure compliance with this national obligation which currently applies to all overseas French territories.

The French Polynesia Ministry of Health strongly recommends choosing a RT-PCR test, which is more sensitive to the detection of COVID-19.

All arriving travelers must present a negative antigen or PCR test result that will not be more than 24 hours old at the time of arrival in Tahiti.

## ADDITIONAL TESTS ON ARRIVAL IN TAHITI

On arrival in Tahiti, all travelers are subject to additional tests carried out by the authorities.

The results are sent within a maximum of 72 hours by email.

Travelers retrieve their results from their email address.

These results may be demanded at any time by the local authorities.

Failure to present may result in a sanction or a fine.

In this context, it is important that travelers enter, in their ETIS form, a correct email address to which they have access during their stay.

## **Important Clarifications**

Duration of isolation in case of a positive test on arrival or during the stay:

If a traveler tests positive upon arrival or during their stay, the duration of isolation is now reduced to:

- Vaccinated: 7 days in accommodations on the island where the traveler received the positive test
- Case of contact: 7 days of strict compliance with barrier measures by avoiding all non-essential contact (prophylactic isolation)

Calculating the delay to complete tests prior to departure to Tahiti:

Details for calculating the time needed to complete the test before departure:

- 1. Direct flight (LAX SFO HNL to PPT): 24 hours before the scheduled time of departure to PPT
- 2. Flight with connection (transit, not stop over), made under a single reservation file: 24 hours before the scheduled departure time of the first flight (ex: from Paris, Nice, NYC, etc.)
- 3. If the flights have been booked separately in several different reservation files or if the connection lasts more than 24 hours, only the last leg is taken into consideration so 24 hours before the scheduled departure time to Papeete from LAX or SFO or HNL

### **Mandatory Electronic Travel Registration**

Guest must register on the ETIS site between 6 to 30 days before flight departure to French Polynesia to obtain their registration certificate to enter French Polynesia. Registration certificate must be shown to the airline before boarding. Guests pay XFP 5000 (approximately USD \$50) to register. https://www.etis.pf/en/

French Polynesia requires all individuals who were vaccinated more than nine months prior to arrival to have received a booster shot. Proof of accepted COVID-19 vaccination <u>plus</u> booster must be uploaded to the ETIS in order to board the flight to French Polynesia.

# Vaccines accepted by French Polynesia (Please note that these differ from Oceania Cruises' accepted COVID-19 vaccines)

- Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Janssen, Covieshield, R-Covi, Fiocruz (or recognized as an equivalent by ANSM or EMA-like)
- Novavax and Covovax
- \*Sinopharm or Sinovac both doses <u>plus</u> a dose of mRNA vaccine (either Pfizer or Moderna) 4 weeks after last dose was given (in addition to the Sinopharm or Sinovac vaccines).

#### AIRPORT TESTING AVAILABILITY IN LOS ANGELES & SAN FRANCISCO

## LAX (Los Angeles International Airport) Rapid Covid Testing

Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) now offers guests two types of COVID-19 tests in the terminal area at three testing locations: the primary lab across from Terminal 6 and two satellite locations in Terminal 2 and the other in the Tom Bradley International Terminal. The tests are provided by Clarity

Labs and processed in a state-of-the-art, on-site laboratory, providing a convenient and safe option for testing before or after travel.

The laboratory offers a standard PCR test (nasal-swab Polymerase Chain Reaction) for \$125 with results returned within 24 hours, or \$175 for priority results in 3-5 hours. Rapid PCR tests with results in one hour are available for \$199. Antigen tests are offered at the Tom Bradley International Terminal daily with results available in one hour for a cost of \$80.

Test results are returned to guests electronically. Guests will receive an itemized receipt to submit to their insurance providers for reimbursement, if the tests are covered by their healthcare provider. Please note that the airport does not receive test results or personal information from customers. LAX's COVID-19 testing lab is certified as a trusted testing partner by the State of Hawaii and tests are eligible to meet current travel requirements to the state.

#### Which Test Should I Take?

PCR tests are required to enter certain destinations or skip quarantine periods upon arrival. Antigen tests provide fastest results, cost less and may be accepted by certain airlines and destinations that allow an antigen test in place of a PCR test.

Customers are responsible for knowing the type of test results that are acceptable for their destination or purpose for testing. Please check with your airline or destination to determine which test is accepted.

## **Appointments:**

Appointments are required and can be <u>booked online here</u>. Patients must schedule their appointment for testing online, prior to checking into the desired testing location.
